



## 2022 Roving Crews

- WisCorps will host two Roving Field Crews during the 2022 Fall session
- Crews will move throughout Wisconsin serving on conservation projects alongside non-profits, city, county & state agency staff  
**Project partners:** Kenosha County, Ozaukee County, St. Croix County, City & County of Waupaca, Driftless Area Land Conservancy, Lakeshore Natural Resources Partnership, and Chequamegon Area Mountain Bike Association (CAMBA)
- Projects include trail building/maintenance, invasive species management, carpentry, and tree planting
- Participants should expect mostly front-country tent camping accommodations throughout their 8-10 week term



## 2022 Wetland Restoration Crew

- WisCorps will host one Wetland Restoration Crew during the 2022 Fall session
- While serving within Indiana Dunes National Park, participants will learn about wetland restoration techniques alongside National Park Service staff
- Typical projects include backpack spraying invasive species, planting native species, seed collections, power brush cutting and habitat restoration
- Crew Housing near Indiana Dunes National Park will be provided
