



2022 FALL Roving Crews

- WisCorps will host THREE Roving Field Crews during the 2022 Fall session
- Crews will move throughout Wisconsin serving on conservation projects alongside non-profits, city, county & state agency staff
Project partners: Ice Age Trail Alliance, Driftless Area Land Conservancy, North Country Trail Association, Ozaukee County, Lake Superior National Estuarine Research Reserve, Lakeshore Natural Resource Partnership, City of Sheboygan, and Maywood Environmental Park.
- Projects include trail building/maintenance, invasive species management, carpentry, and tree planting
- Participants should expect mostly front-country tent camping accommodations throughout their 8-10 week term



2022 FALL Wetland Restoration Crew

- WisCorps will host ONE Wetland Restoration Crew during the 2022 Fall session
- While serving within Indiana Dunes National Park, participants will learn about wetland restoration techniques alongside National Park Service staff
- Typical projects include backpack spraying invasive species, planting native species, seed collections, power brush cutting and habitat restoration
- Crew Housing near Indiana Dunes National Park will be provided
